



Lighting

The poles carrying the main lighting are set back 5 m from the river thereby affirming the space of the river bed visually.
 The lighting on poles in the river serves as an ambient light source - candles.
 The glass pavilions on the northern bank function as lighting for the terraces.
 The southern bank is lit by the lighted facades of the pavilions, and lighting is also inserted into the retaining walls next to the ramps.
 All green surfaces are watered with sprinklers - the nozzles provide a lighting which is filtered through mist.

Water

Water in water:
 - fountains are located in the river - islands of sprinkler nozzles defined as shallow cubes above a liquid mirror

Water on the northern bank:
 - pool for swans
 - pool for geese
 - fields of sprinklers for hot summer days
 - fields of sprinklers for watering plantings

Benches

Benches are melded with the topography - they act as cuts in the banks, while wooden seating elements are inserted into the grassy areas.

Terraces

All terraces are wooden decks on which are placed chairs and tables - cubes of wood / for example oak open to the humidification process.

Traffic

The northern shore from the automotive entrance at the market on the west to the eastern edge of the competition zone is planned as a pedestrian and bicycle zone. Parking for bikes is planned on two locations.
 The southern shore has a bicycle path, a path for recreational running as well as a pedestrian path.

Traffic on the Drava River

is planned with landing docks along both banks. Private boats are docked at a number of places on the northern and southern shores.

Program

The public space of the northern shore is intended for cultural events, meetings, outing, as well as everyday urban life.
 Sports fields and children's playground add even more activity.
 The southern shore is primarily recreational and hospitality.
 The swimming zone on the southern shore is placed across the way from the closed pool and open air pool.
 The pedestrian bridge could serve as the goal of rowing regattas.
 The western portion of the southern shore is organized for equestrian sports.

Pavilions

The pavilions on the northern shore are transparent objects through which the old city and recreational elements such as bars, art installations, and info points are visible.
 The pavilions on the northern shore are built into the terrain and those closest to the water contain the swimming pool and the equestrian club. The Marbor 2012 pavilion is located on Tabor Square.
 The Pavilions hanging between the arches of the bridge contain souvenirs and antiques.

Time

The project's concept is adjustable in its phasing - it is not necessary for all of the fields to be realized before 2012, only those in strategic locations.
 2010-2012
 - development of the southern shore
 - Lant
 - Beneda
 - Tabor
 - the promenade along the shore and the burms along the river as well as the lighting
 - a few of the fields in the river
 - the old city - paving and lighting
 2012-2015
 - developing the gardens
 - the celebration of the water surface through water sports
 - art installations
 - the encouragement of public participation - for example the planting of gardens
 2015-2020
 Marbor Eco City 2020

Use

The public space along Marbor's shore will be used 24 hours a day 365 days a year.

Materials

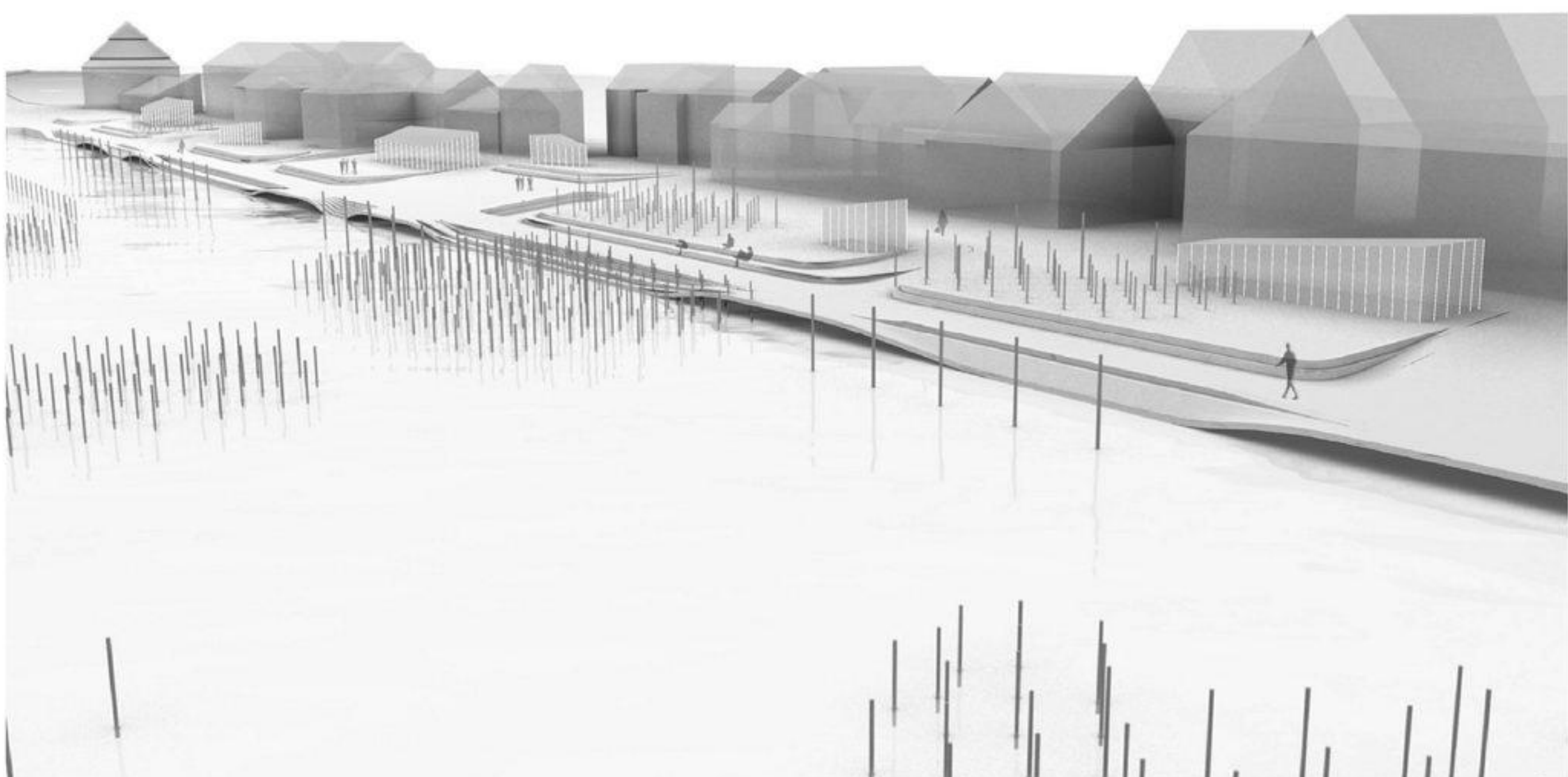
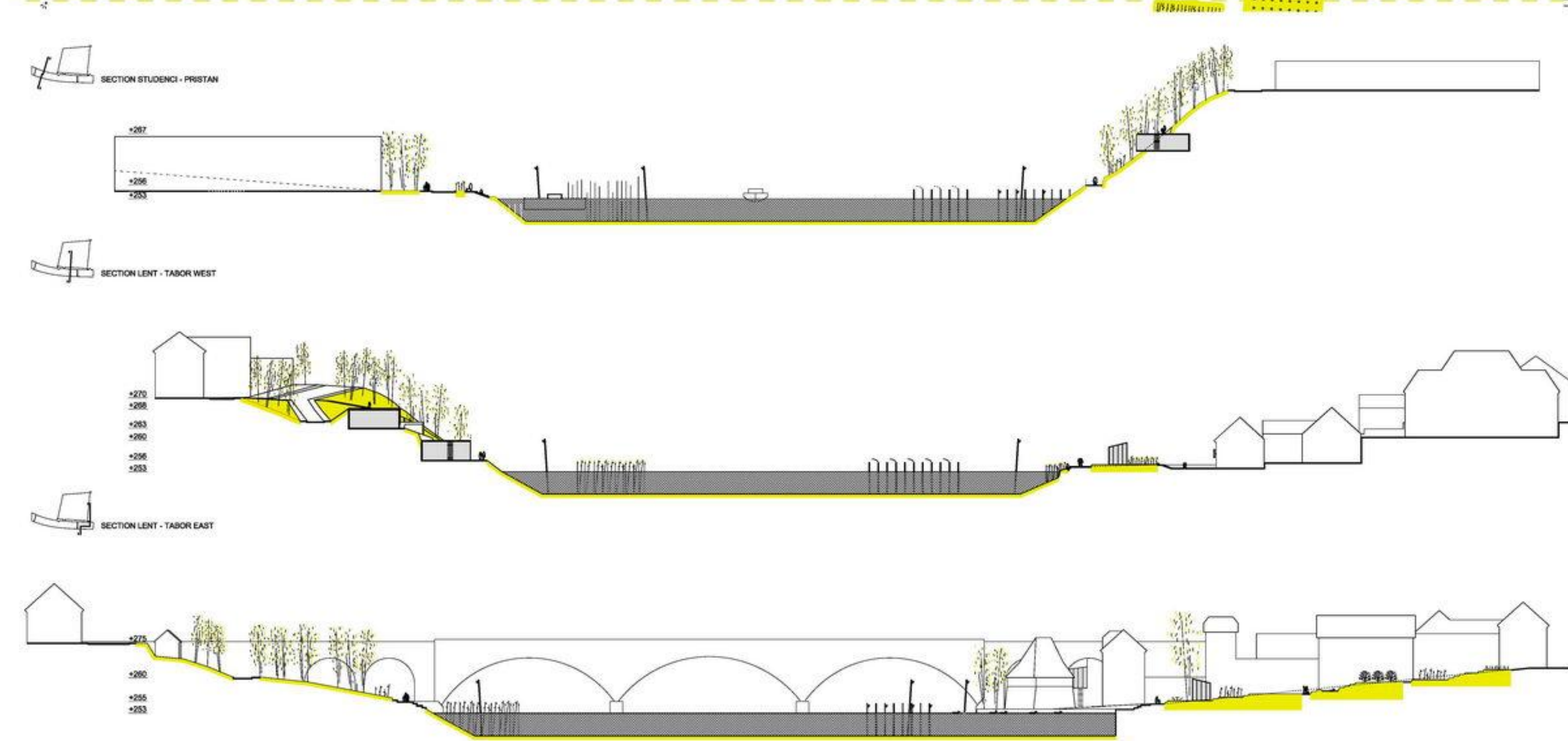
The use of vegetation brings color and scent to the space
 Water and the presence of fountains brings sound to the site
 Wood - humidified oak for the seating elements
 Glass - light construction for the pavilions
 Paving - granite extension of the existing streets, larger around the tunnels

Surfaces

Recycled rubber of various colors for the playground
 Foamy vinyl - for the spaces of the square - like a rug in a living room
 Poured monolithic or prefabricated panel concrete surface - for the promenades, paths through the fields, and the ramps
 The fence for the playing field is a white plastified net on a steel frame

Benefits

An open air stage is planned for special occasions. It will be used as bicycle parking at other times.
 Paving - the triangular portion towards the water will be covered with trees, while the promenade and the space of the stage will be covered with white prefabricated concrete panels. The stage is slightly tilted with the assistance of hydrolic pumps. Elements for locking up bikes are cast into the floor system.
 The field of poles in front of the tunnels - corten steel poles with ambient light
